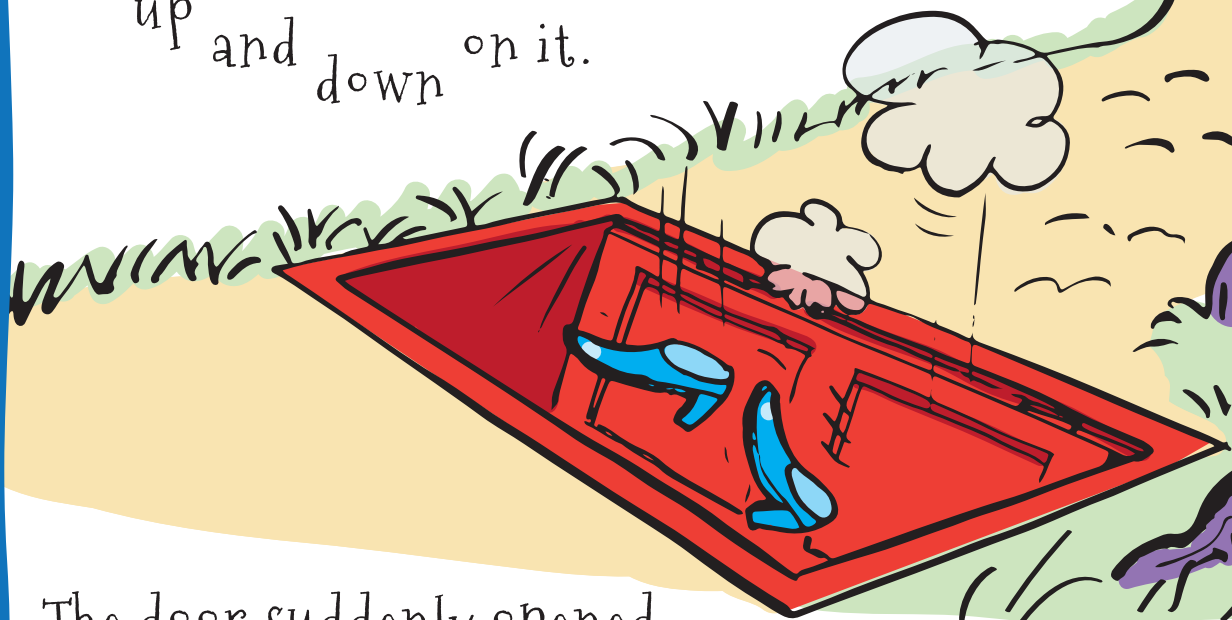


Memory Owl watched

the branch.

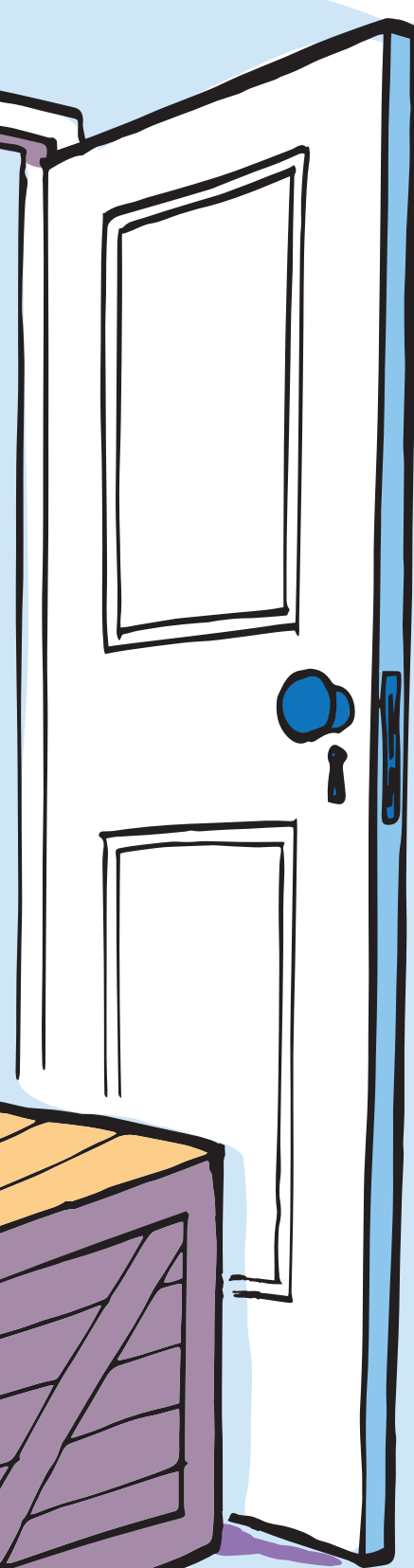
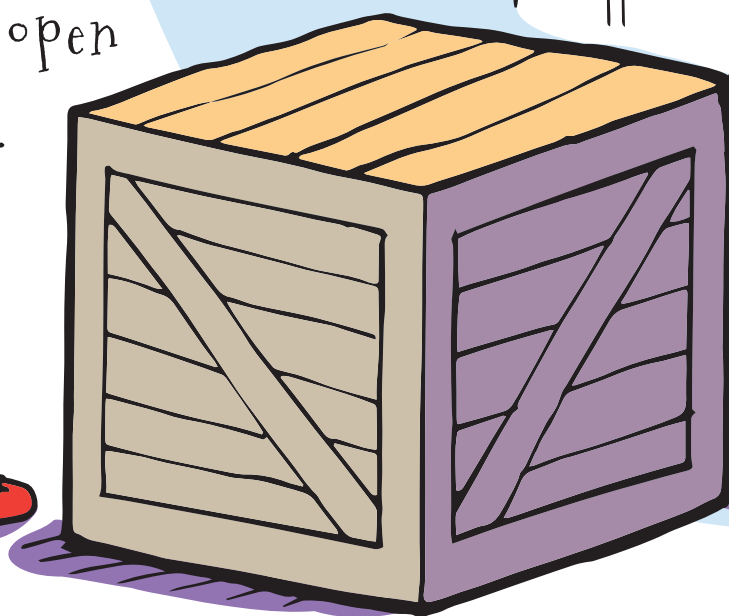


He pulled and pulled and suddenly his shoe came loose and a **stick** broke off and fell to the ground.

for them.

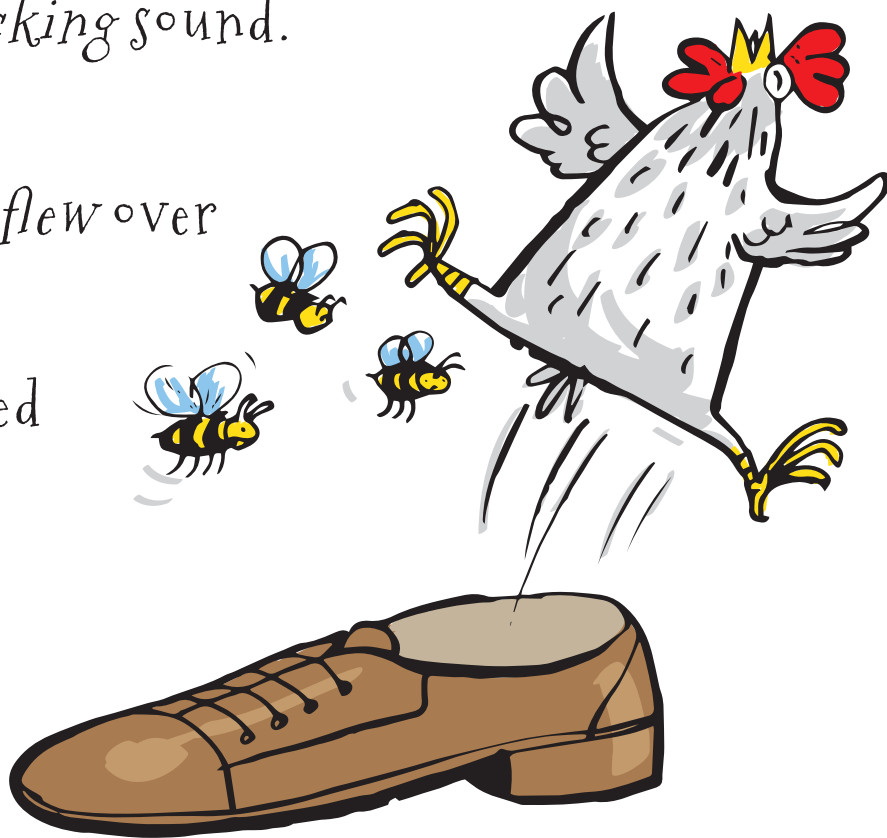




Memory Owl was talking to his bees next to their **hive**, and *noticed* that some bees were buzzing around a **shoe** that was making a *clucking* sound.

into a **teeny shoe**!

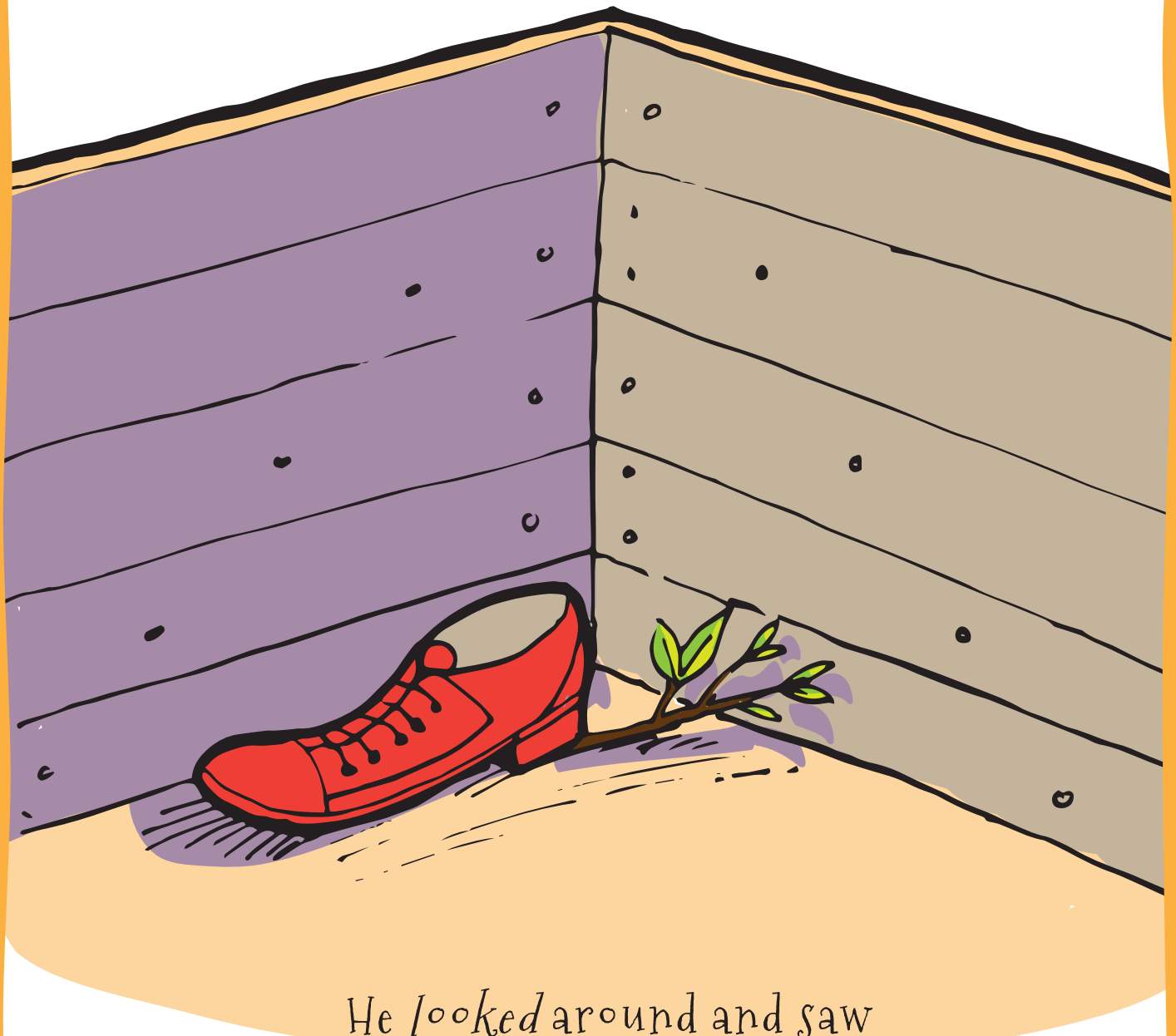

sticking into him.

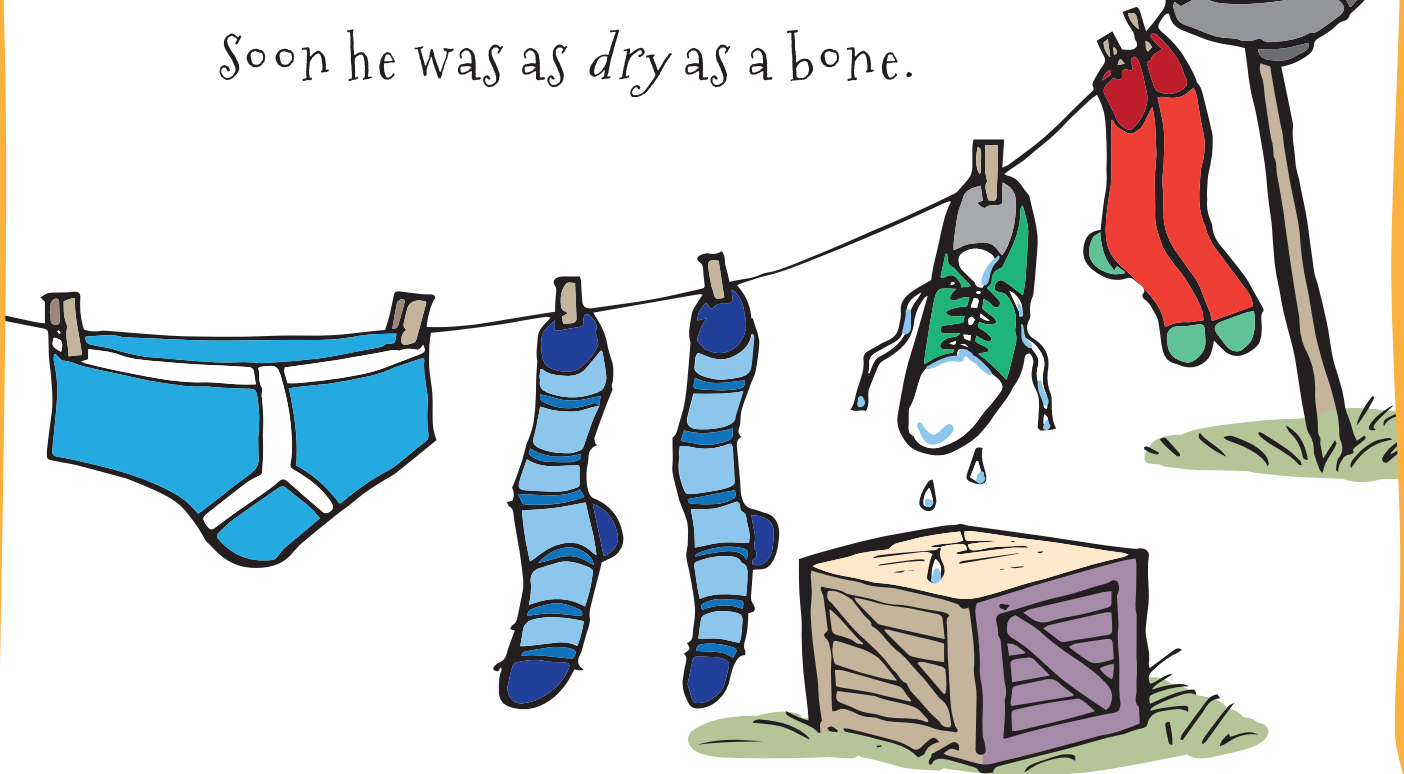


He *looked* around and saw

to *sit in* and have a rest.

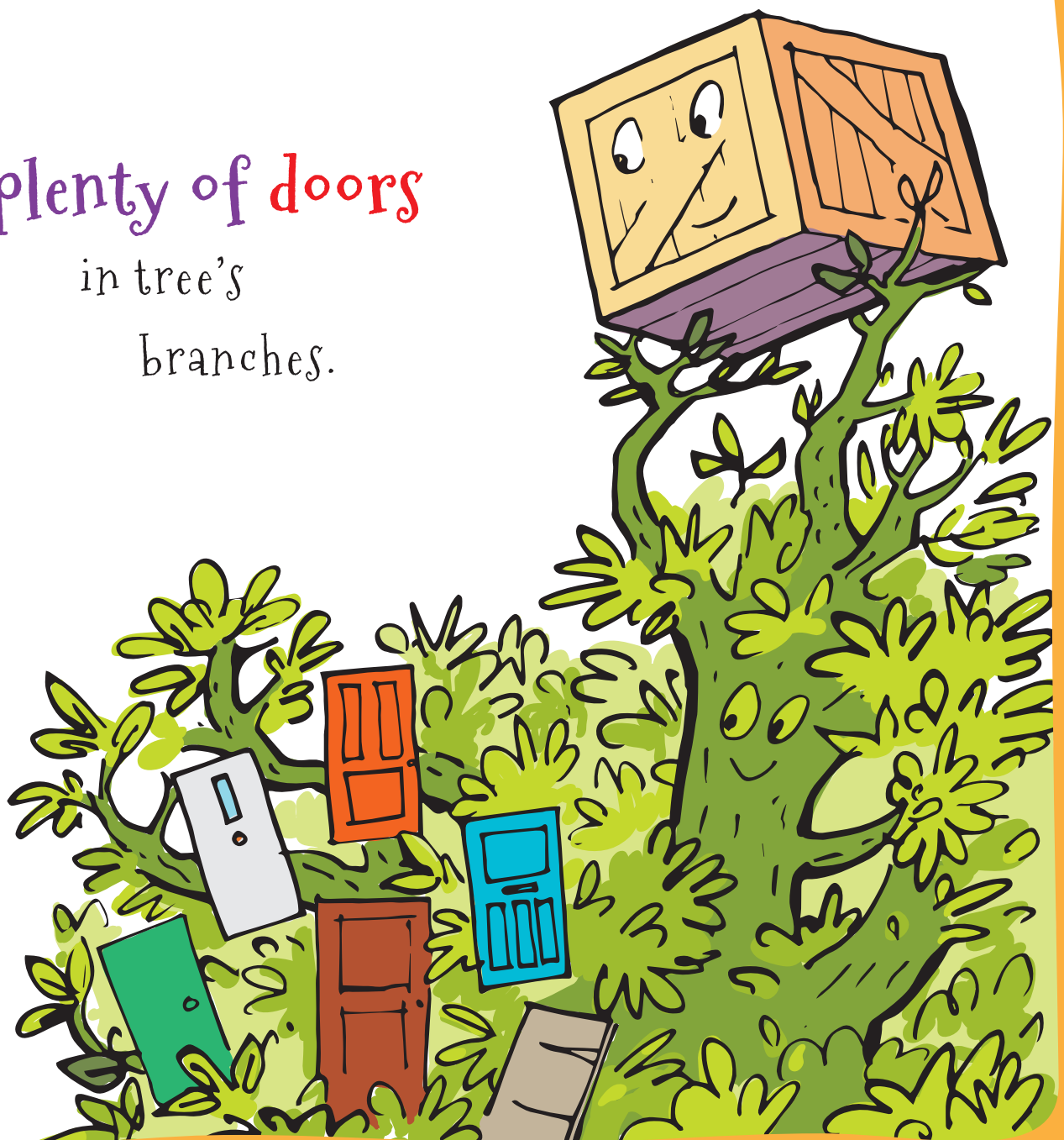
$$6 \times 3 = 18$$

were **plenty of suns**.

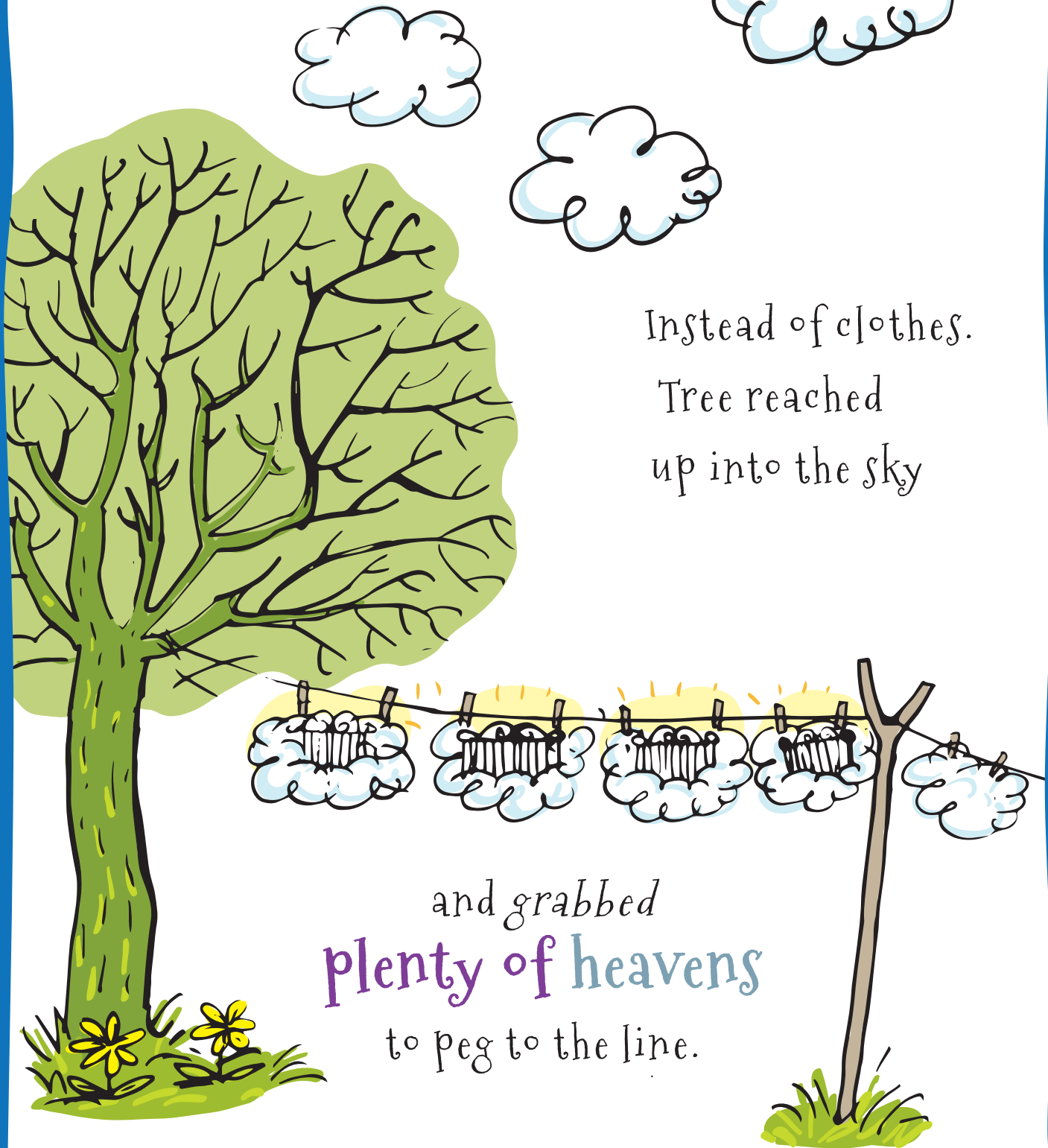

Door woke up to find **crate** sitting in front of him.

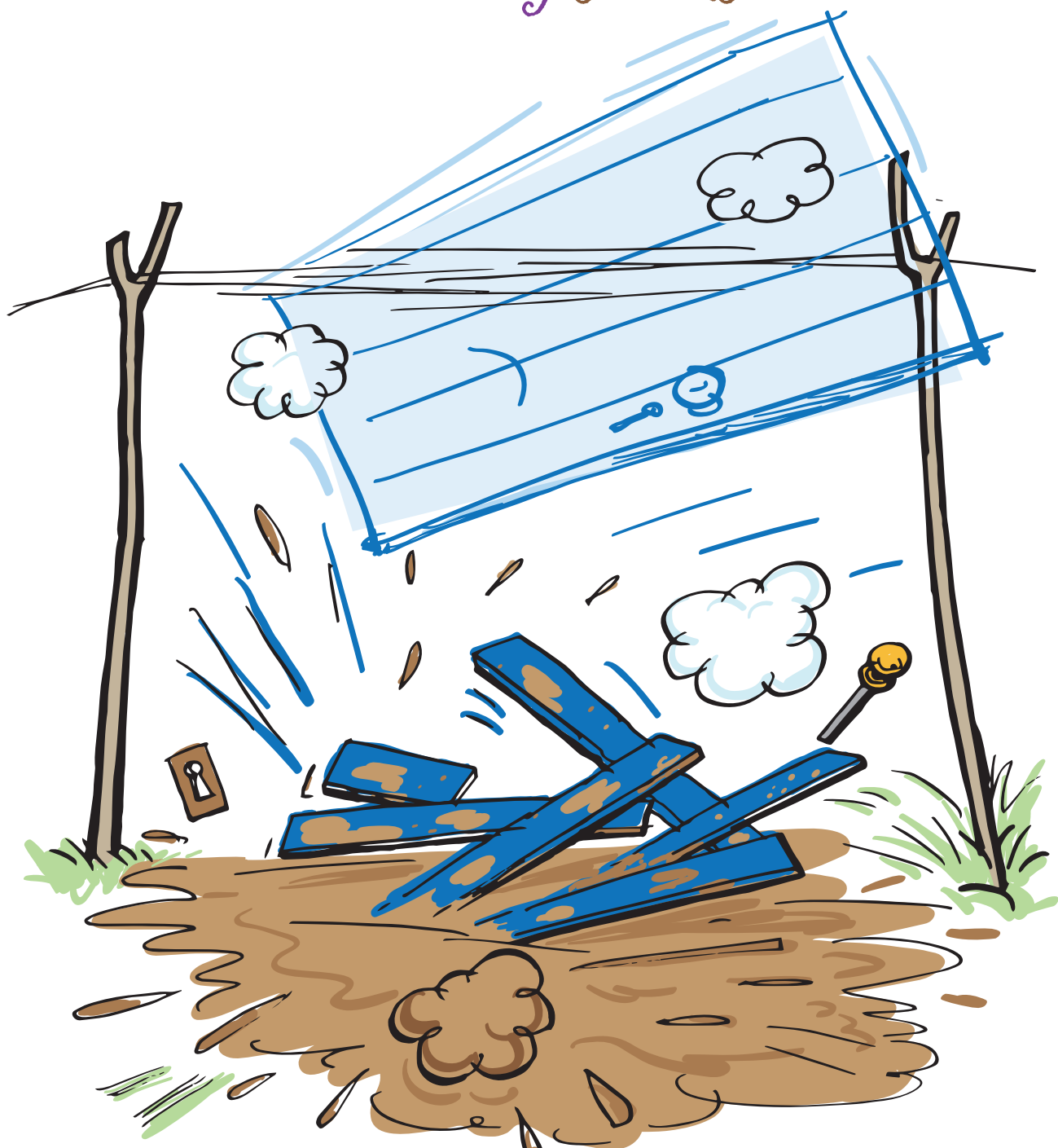
There was a *nasty smell* coming from crate.

out of the hive.



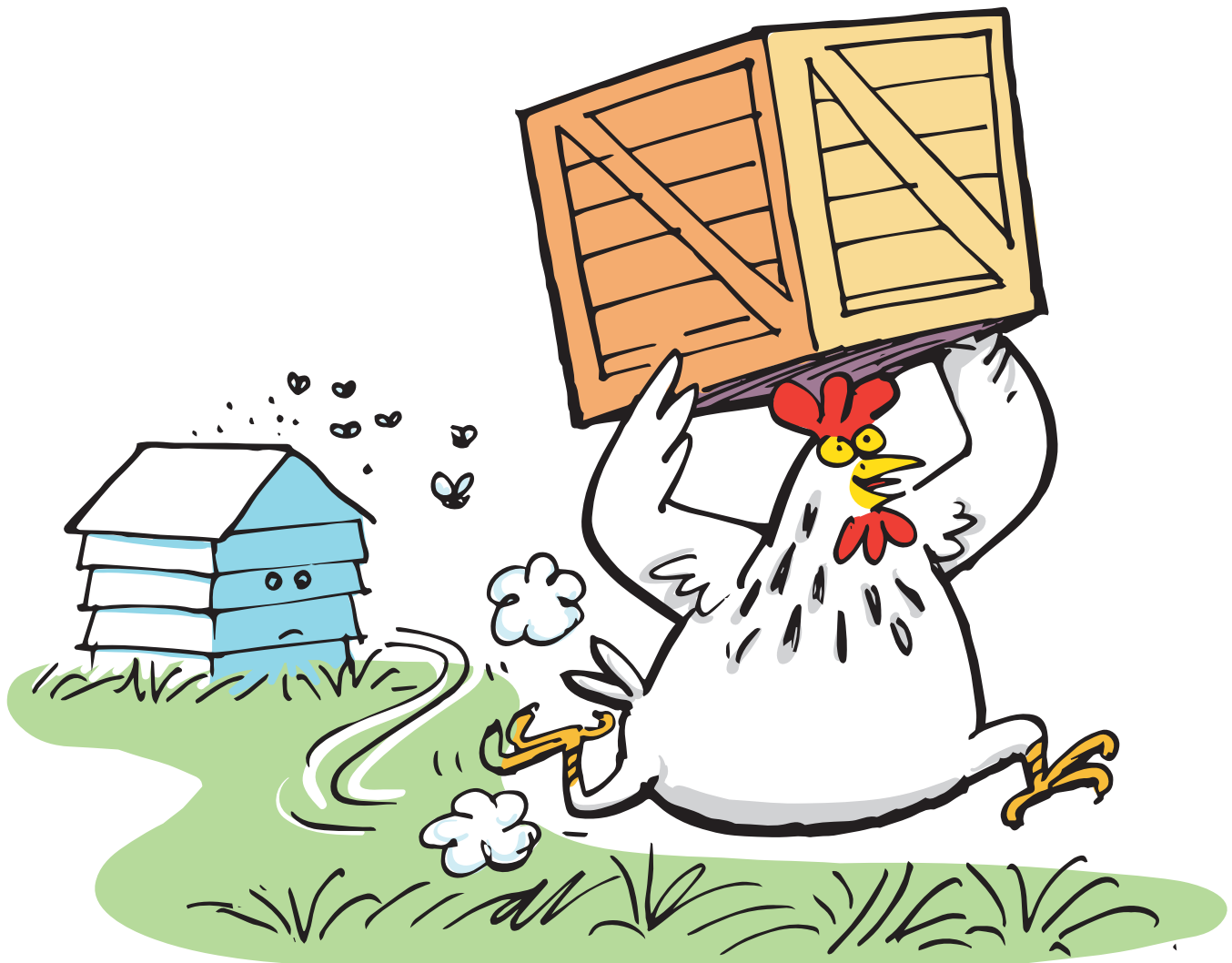
Hive was visiting **h**eaven when he

...becoming a **d**irty **h**ive.

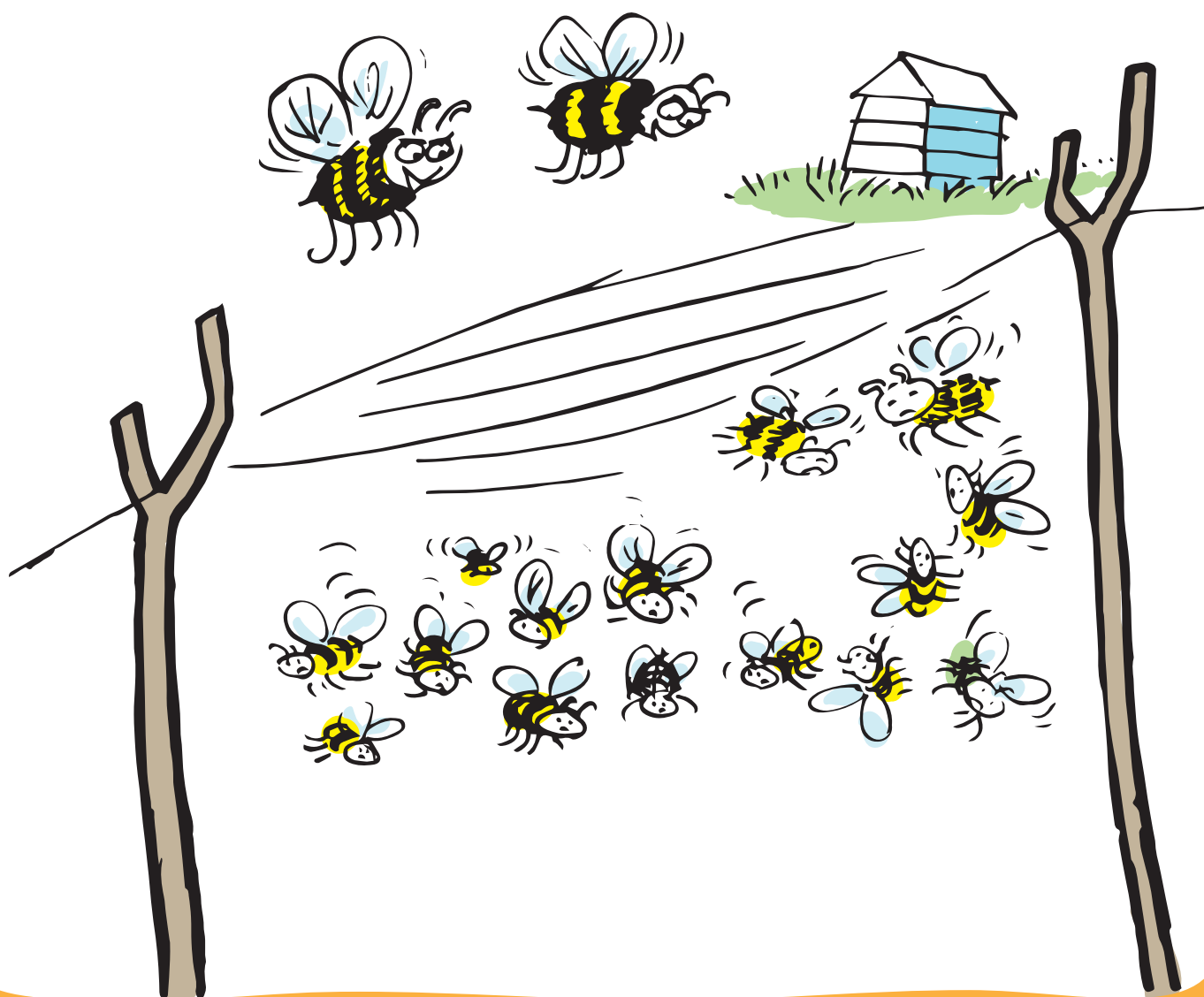
Hive was very *sleepy* and asked

clucking *loudly*.

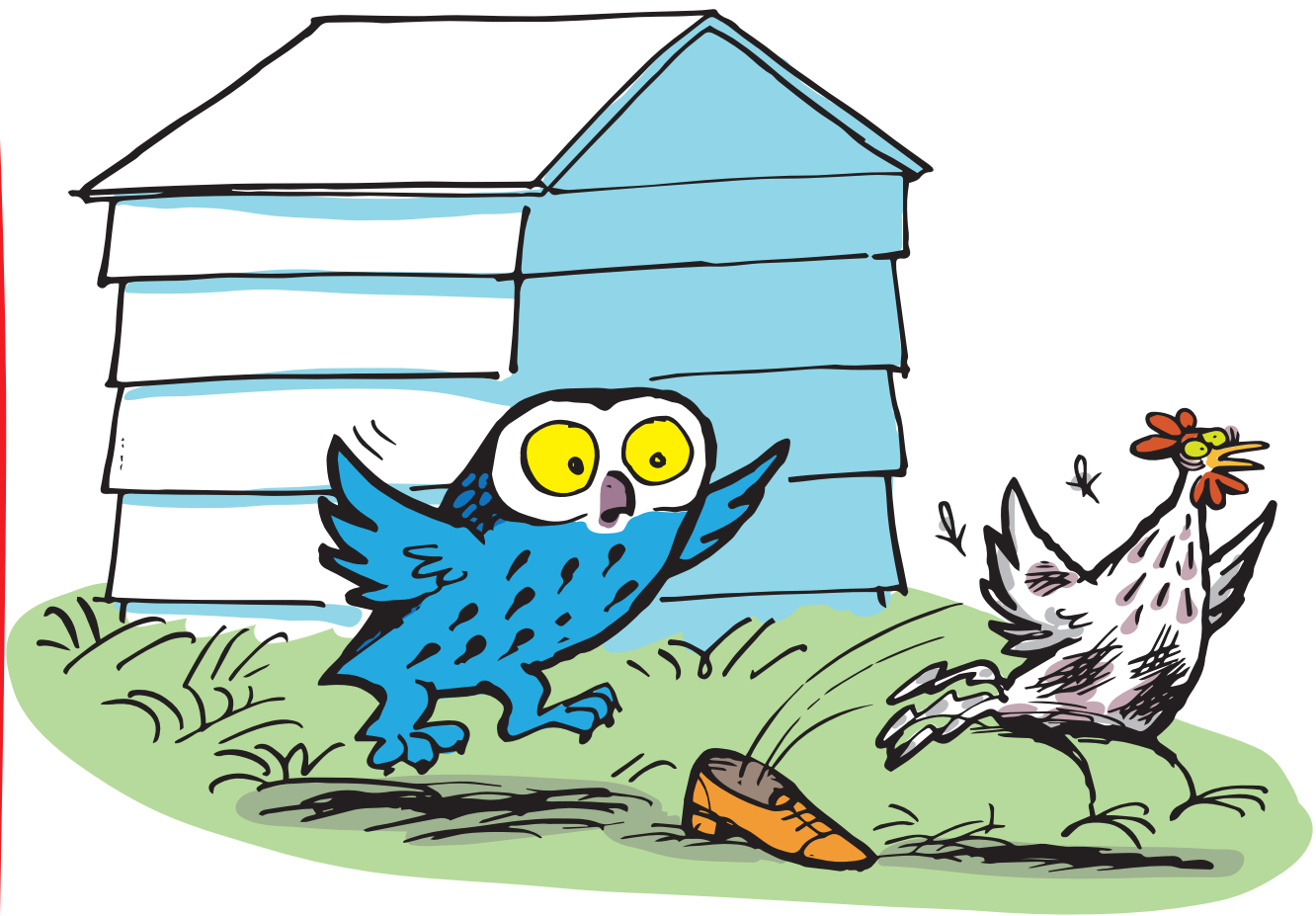


Hive's bees were having

a poor sickly hen.

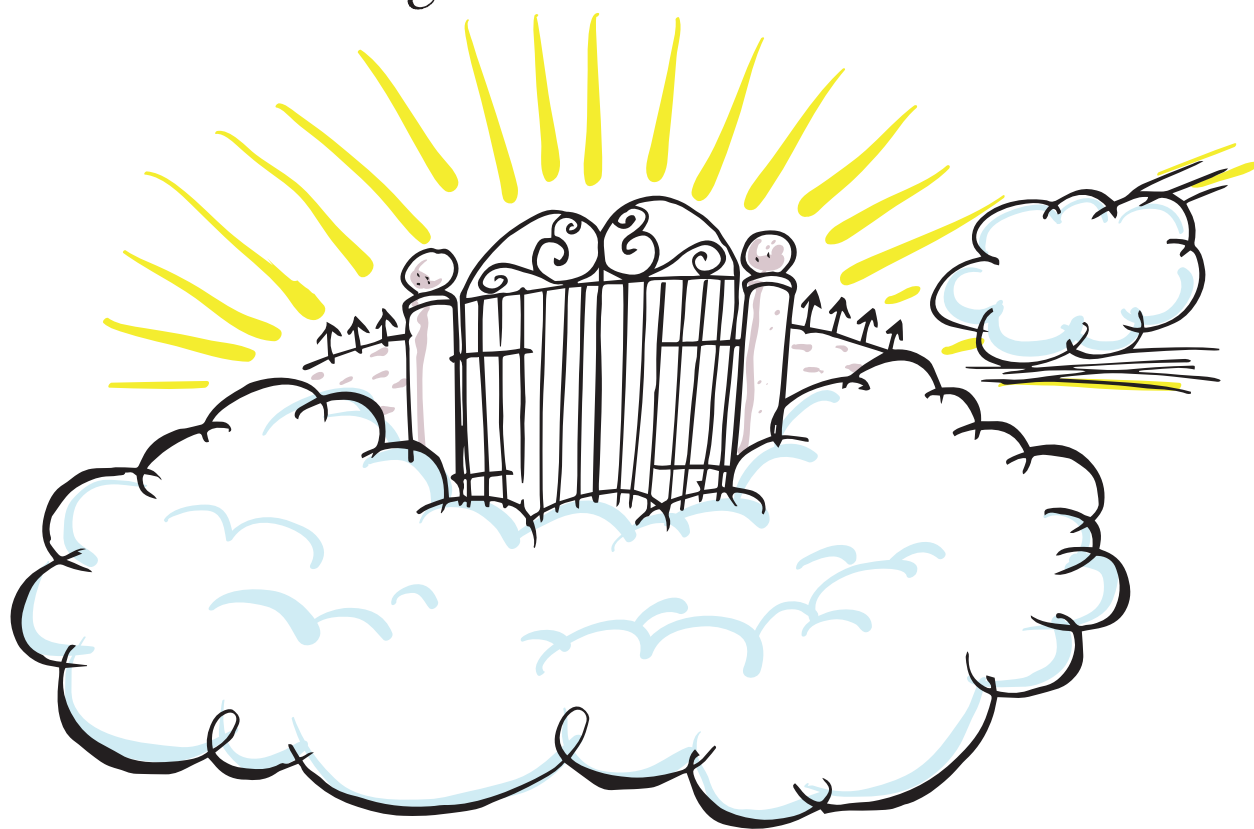


Stick and his best **sticky** friend were

Nifty door then decided to help, and *opened* and *closed* her door so fast, creating a *lovely breeze*, that the clothes were dry in no time.



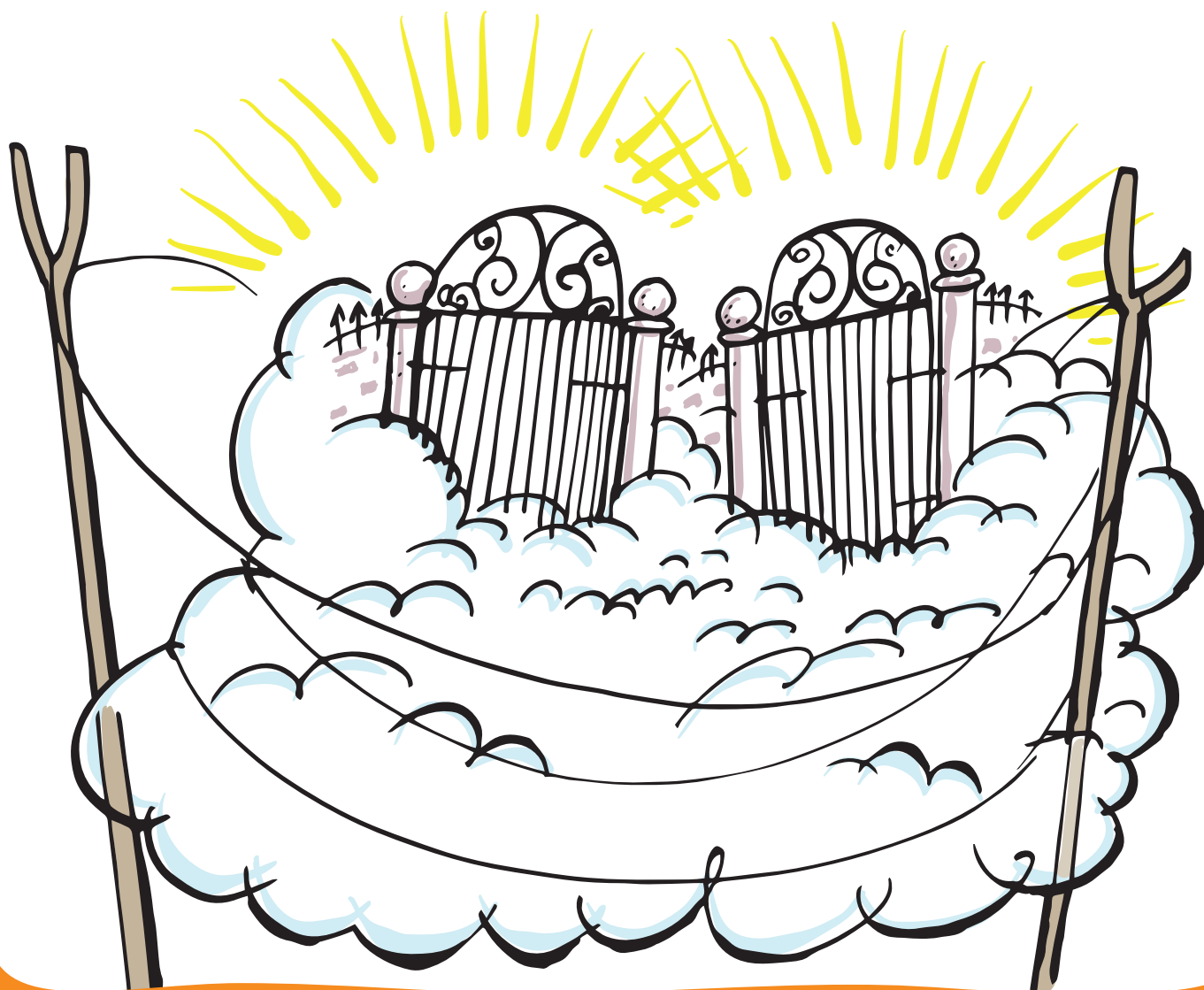
Stick was playing with **teeny shoe**,

so small and *poked* her too hard.



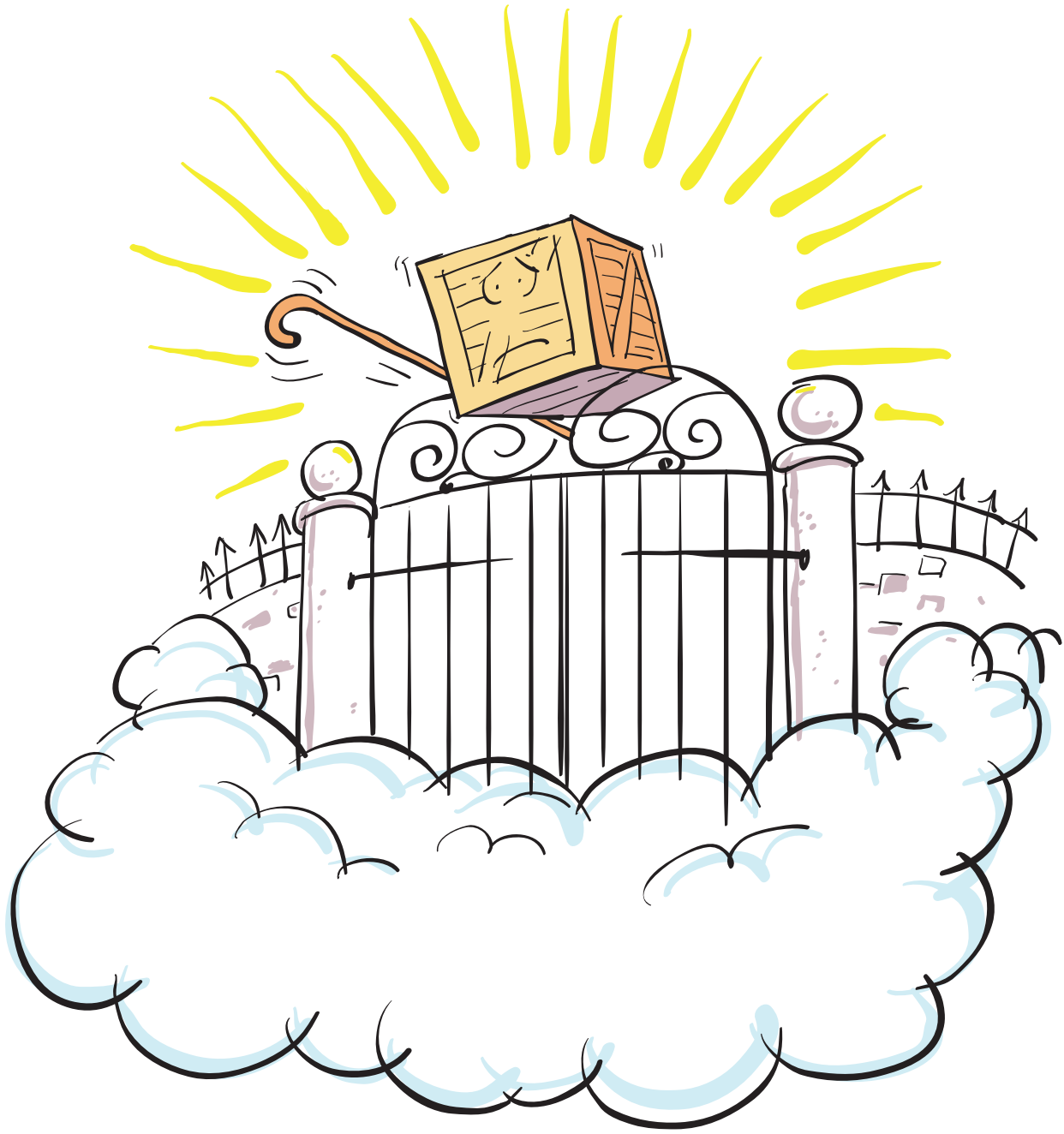
Teeney shoe turned into a

and all his clothes blew off ...



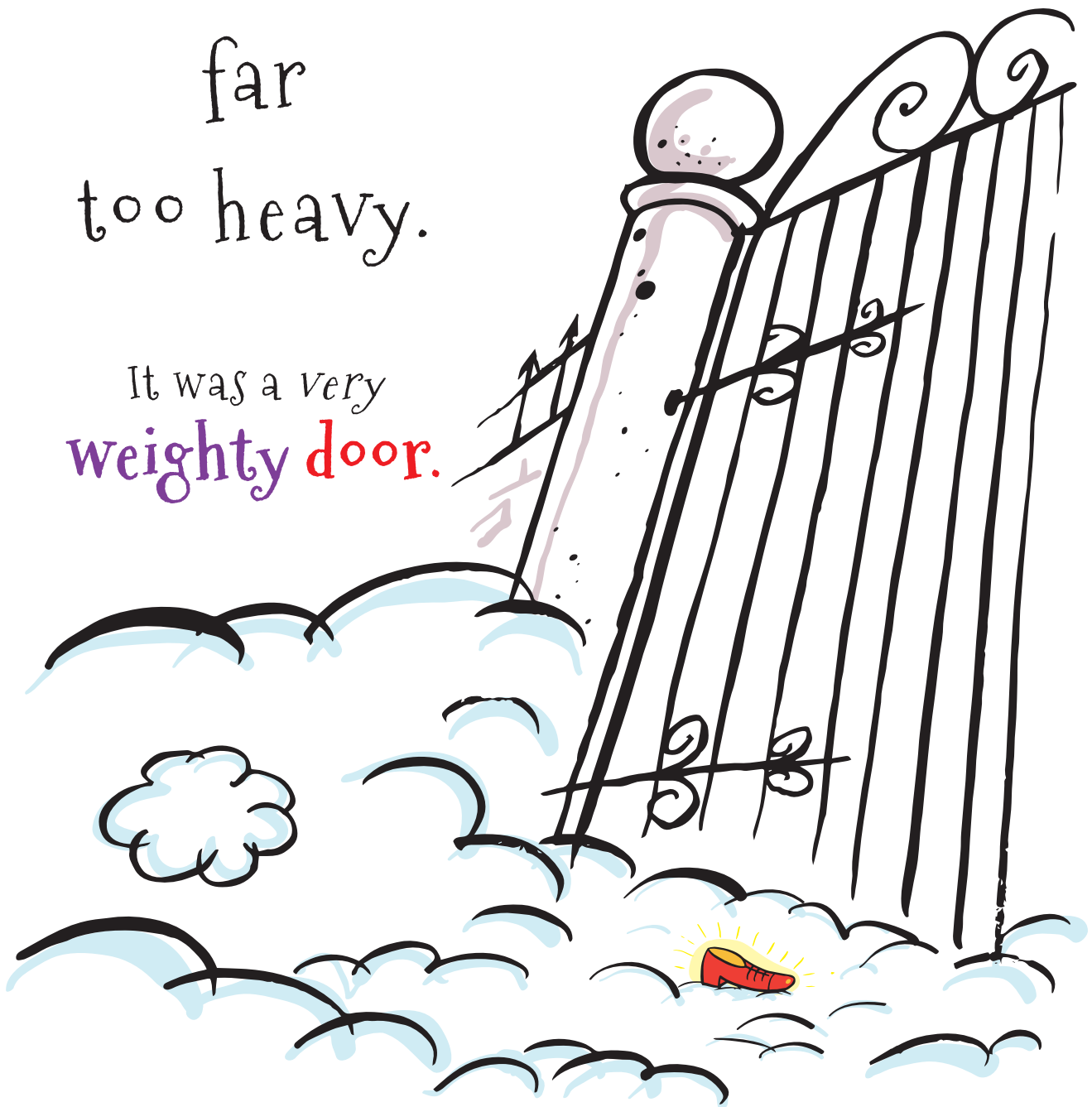
and landed

weighty door.



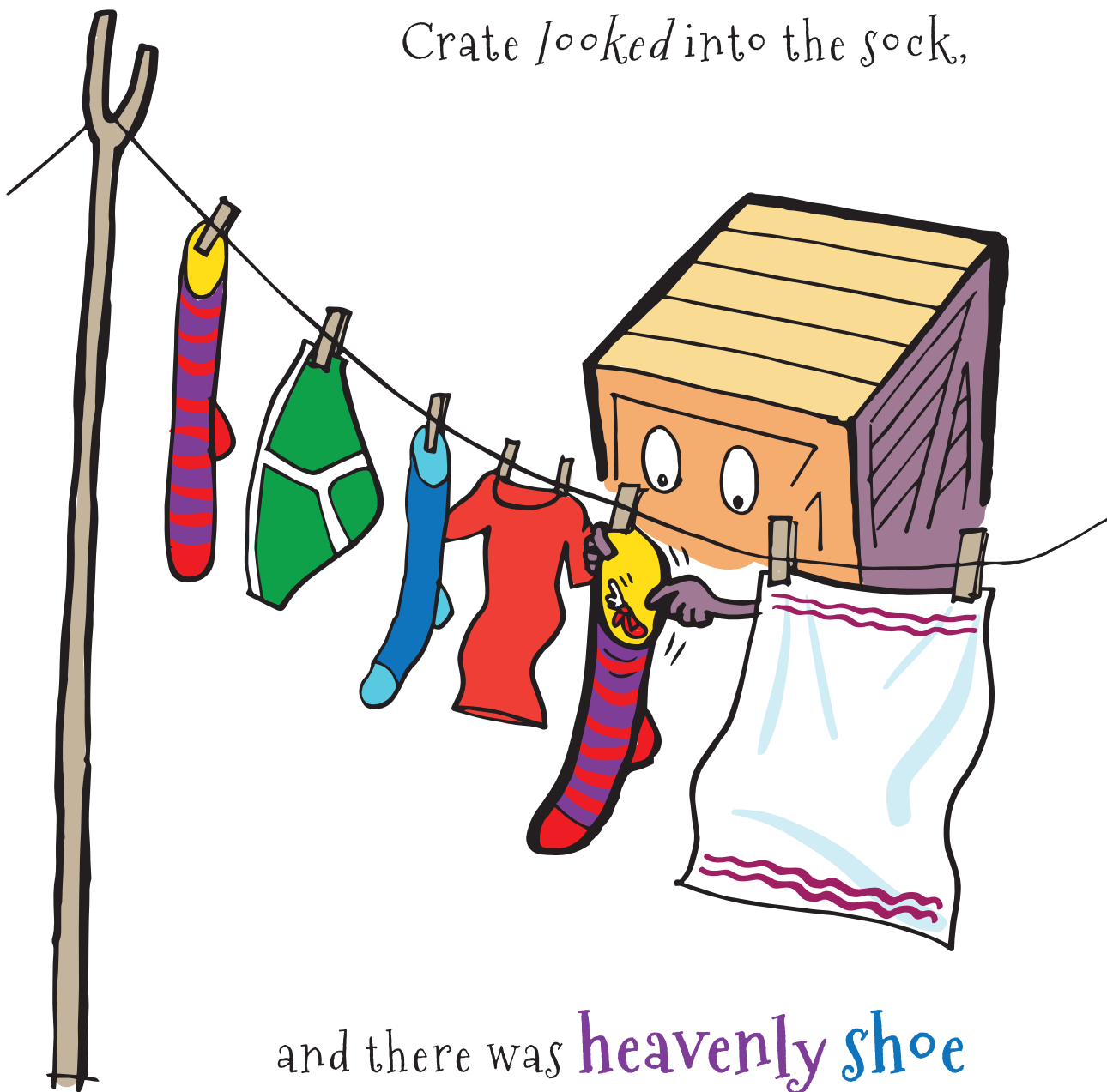
A **crate** and his **crate** friend were *playing*

line's socks.

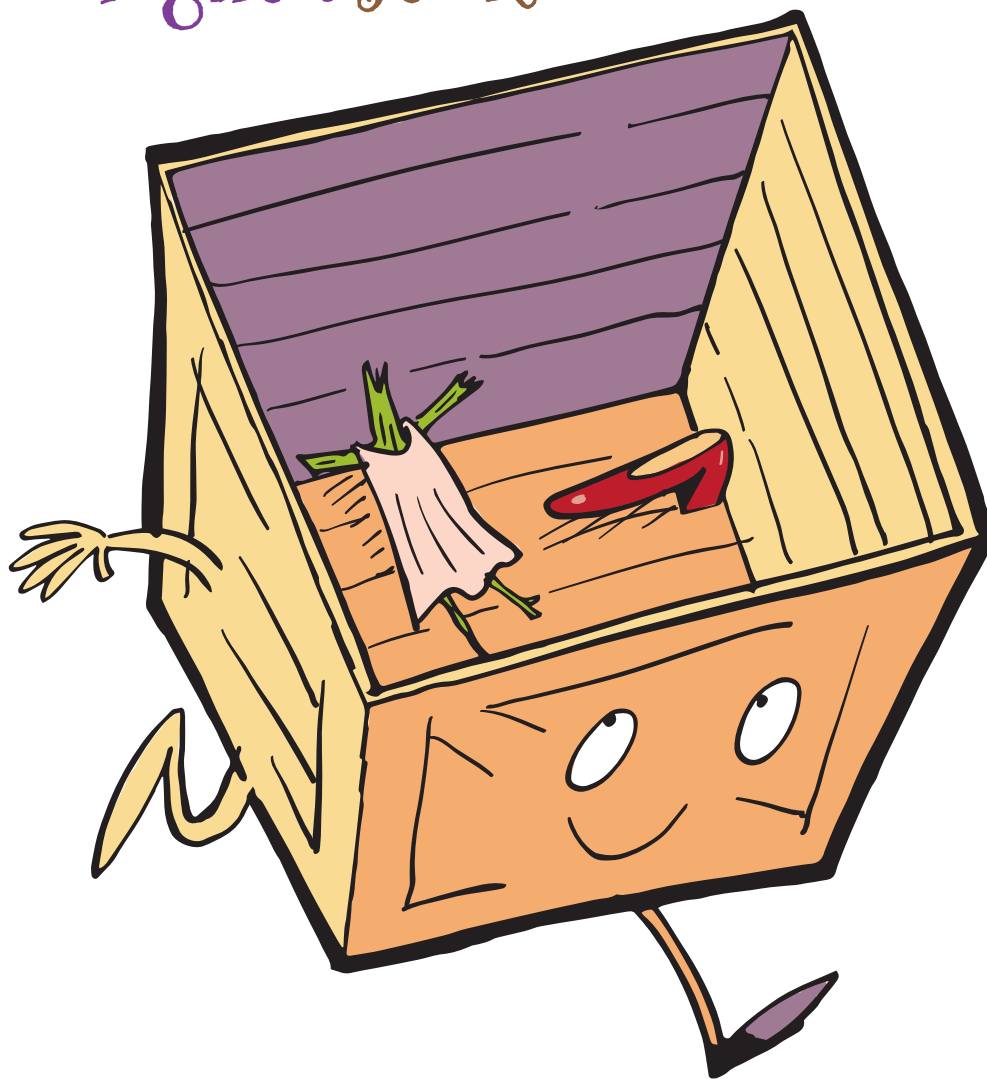
Crate *looked* into the sock,



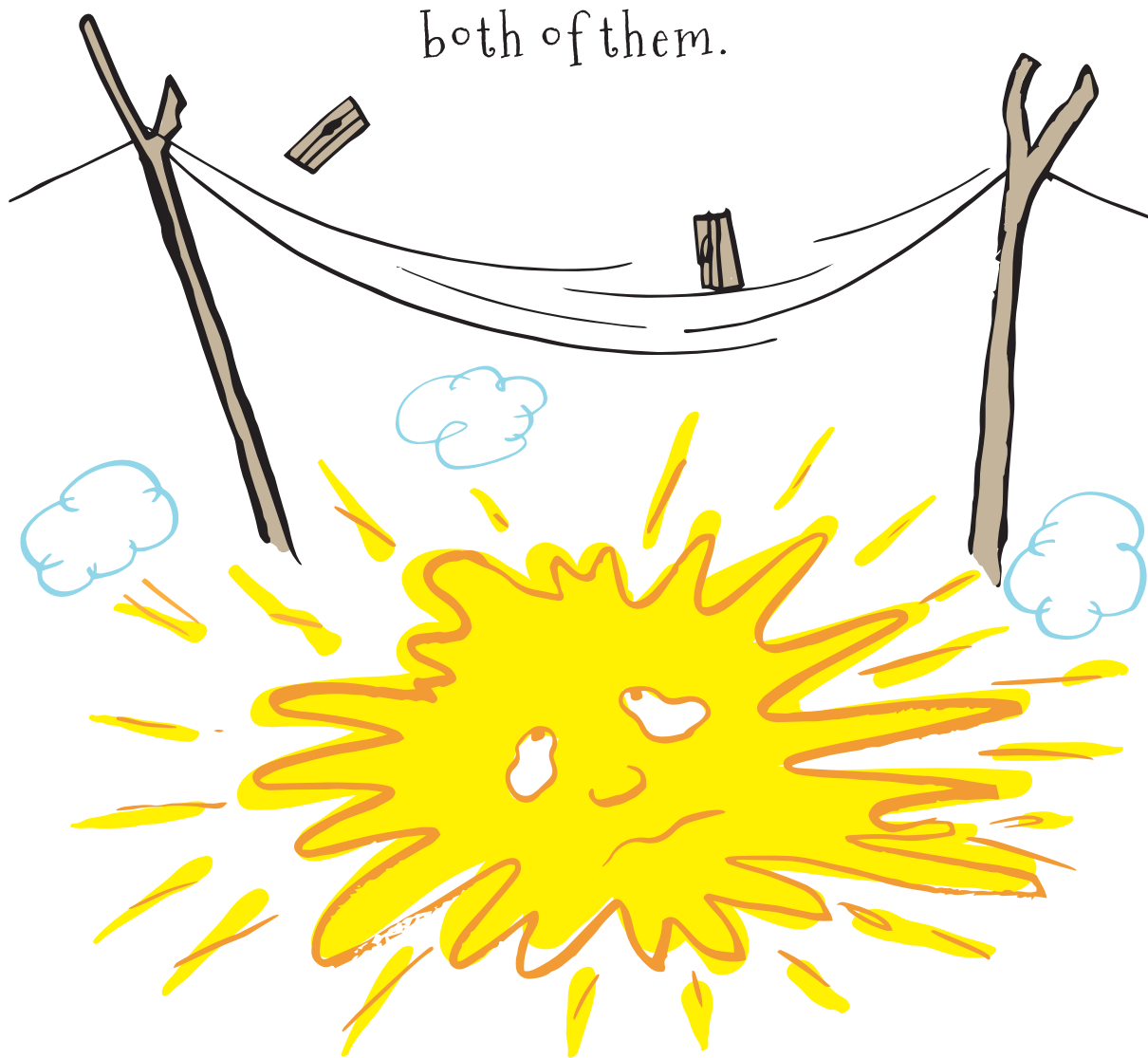
and there was **heavenly shoe**

nightie stick.

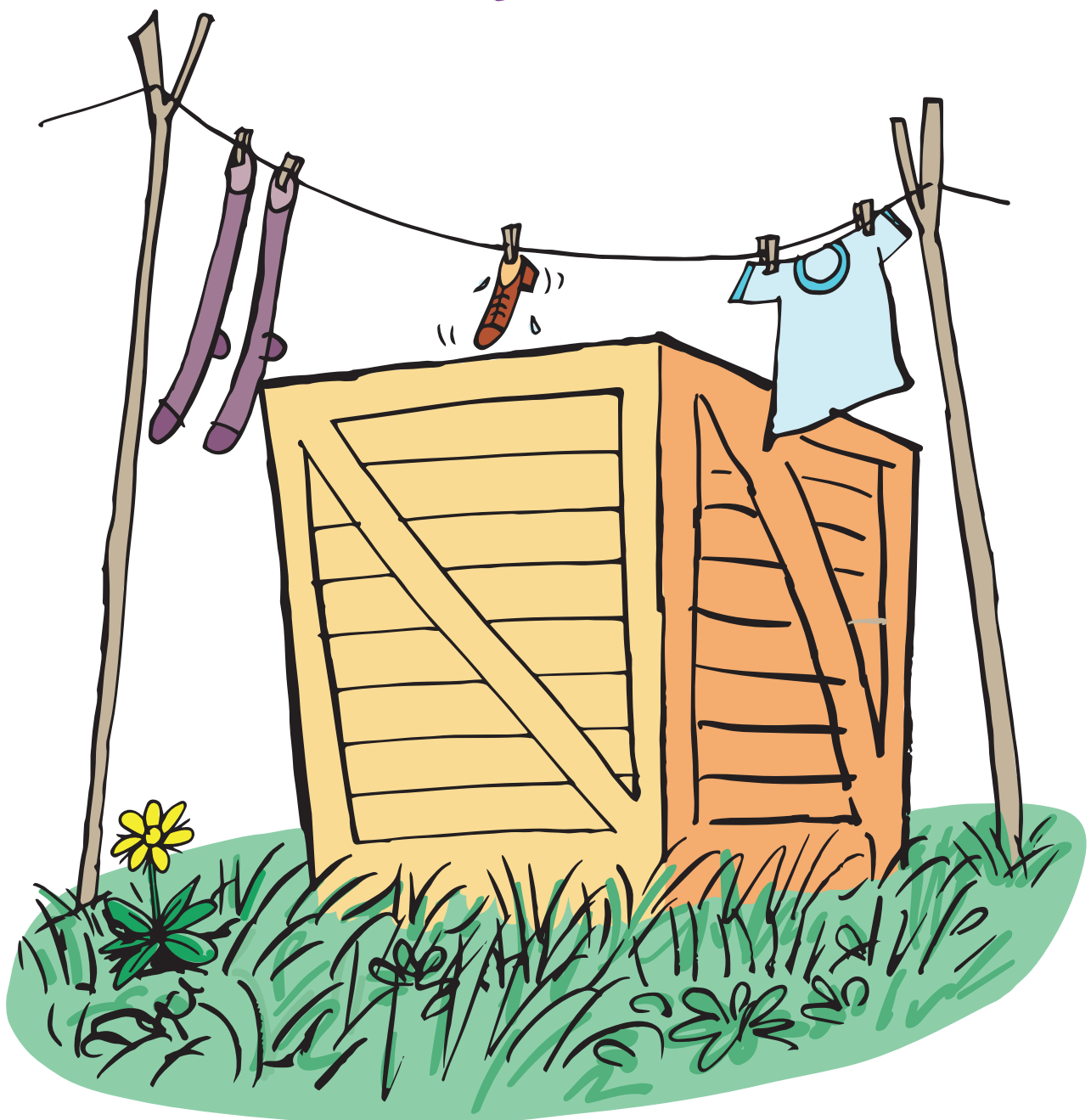


Sun was a bit wet and wanted to dry

was no way that teeny sun was going to fit.

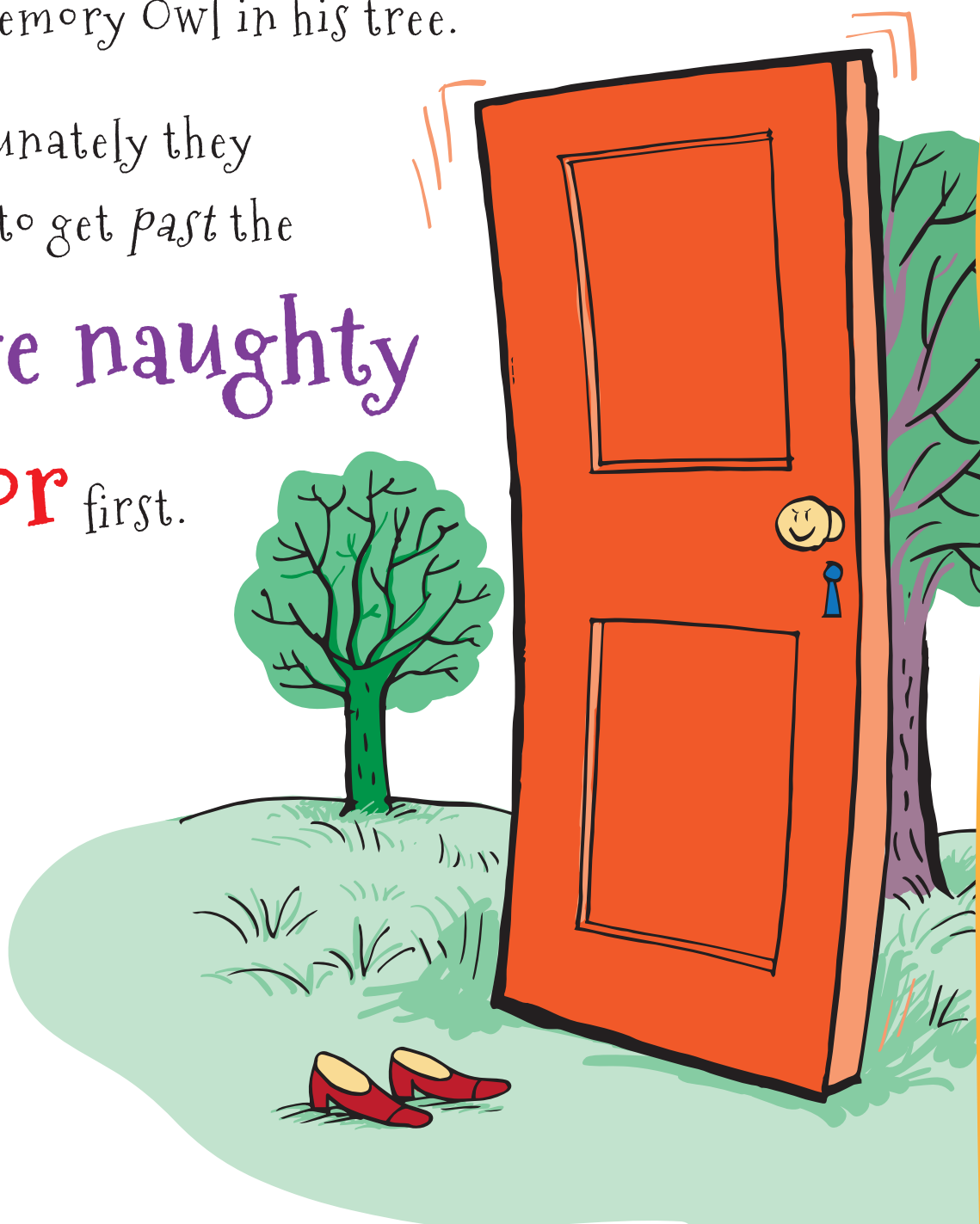
Teeny shoe *ran off* to fetch his friend
