Year 1

Understand a few familiar spoken words and phrases

Respond to familiar rhymes or songs

Answer simple questions

Year 2

Understand a range of familiar spoken words and phrases

Follow a simple two or three word instruction

Join in with familiar rhymes or songs

Ask and answer simple questions

Use simple adjectives to describe a picture or object

Match written words and phrases with pictures or symbols

Year 3

Recognise and respond appropriately to a range of familiar words and phrases

Follow an instruction within a full sentence

Join in with familiar songs and stories

Ask simple questions and respond with a different answer to my peers

Change a few words in a familiar sentence to make a new sentence

Speak clearly to an audience with good pronunciation

Read some familiar words aloud

Remember new words from their reading

Write some words independently

Write a simple sentence with adjectives to describe a picture or object using a word bank

Recognise nouns, adjectives and verbs

Recognise the articles that make nouns masculine or feminine

Year 4

Accurately repeat the sounds heard in songs and rhymes

Ask and answer simple questions about different topics

Change simple sentences they have heard to make new sentences

Read aloud with good pronunciation

Understand and read aloud several familiar phrases and sentences

Follow the words of a text when it is being read aloud

Write a range of words and some short phrases from memory

Write sentences to describe people and things using a range of adjectives, using remembered words and example sentences for support

Use pronouns and articles appropriately before a noun

Year 5

Understand the main points from a short spoken passage

Match the spoken version of most known words to their spelling

Give and justify opinions

Make changes to a complex sentence to create a new sentence with altered meaning

Change tone to show the difference between a question and statement

Prepare a short speech to say in front of an audience

Understand the main points from a short written text

Learn a new song or poem through the written word

Use a dictionary to find new words about a topic

Write phrases and some simple sentences from memory

Write sentences to describe people and things using a range of adjectives and begin to use verbs to show what they are doing

Make changes to an adjective so it agrees with the masculine or feminine noun

Form questions

Year 6

Understand the main points, details and opinions from a short spoken passage on a range of subjects

Hold a discussion with others, giving their own ideas

Create and say extended sentences

Use tone and voice to show meaning and keep an audience interested

Understand the main points and some details from a text that contains unfamiliar language, using clues to help me

Use words and phrases learnt from reading or a dictionary

Write simple phrases and sentences from memory and change them to express their own ideas

In a sentence, choose the most appropriate adjectives and verbs
