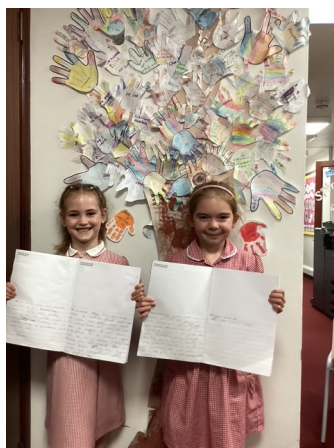
- 4th Place - Jones

Reception class had a blast this week, enjoying all their normal outdoorsy activities, its definitely their happy place. Mrs Thomas :-)





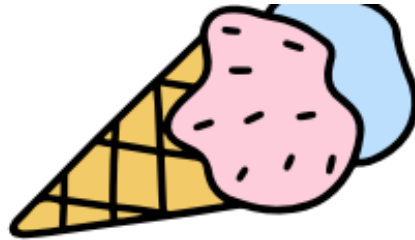
