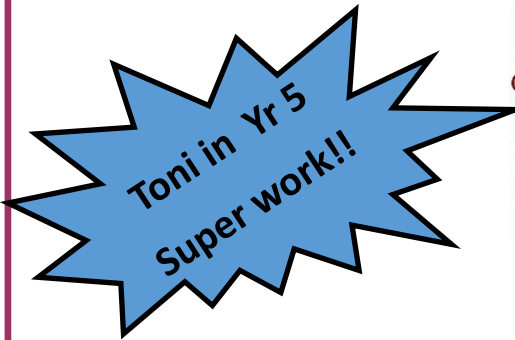
This week's 'School Vision' Award goes to:

"Clara Schumann"

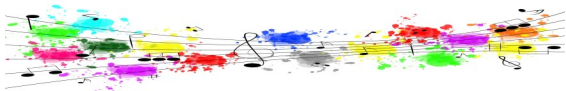
Music Title: Clara Schumann's Scherzo No.2 in C Minor performed by Isata Kanneh-Mason
