It was a great afternoon, even with the rain, and we had lots of fun!!

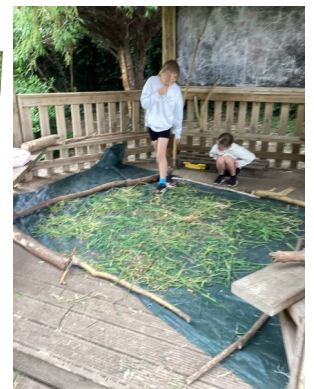

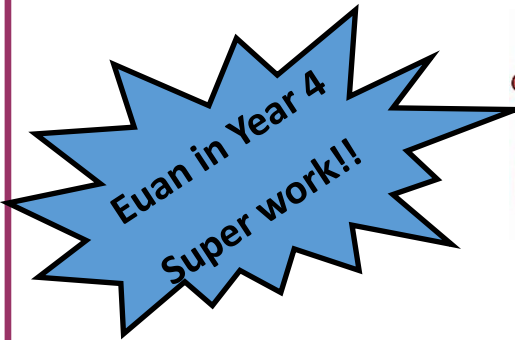
This week's 'School Vision' Award goes to:

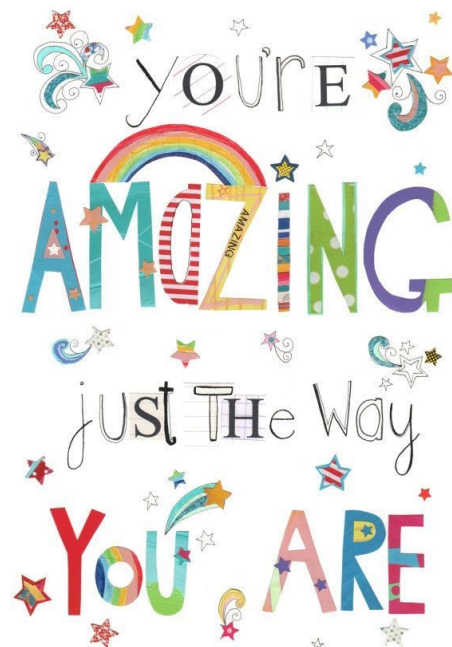

"Clara Schumann"

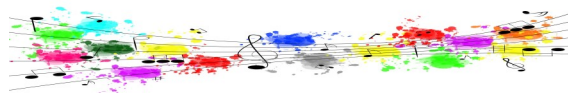
Music Title: Clara Schumann's Scherzo No.2 in C Minor performed by Isata Kanneh-Mason
