Dear Parent/Carers,

On Monday, our Head Boy, Head Girl and myself attended the "Holocaust Memorial Day Service". It was held at the Kindertransport Memorial at Harwich Quay. We travelled down to the Quay, with some staff and pupils from Spring Meadow (they kindly let us ride in their mini bus with them). The service itself was truly lovely. There was a speech by Mayor Pam Morrison; poems were read by Tim Pass and Olivia O and Olivia E (both Olivia's are pupils are Harwich and Dovercourt High School) and a Jewish Memorial Prayer was read out by Beverley Levy from Colchester Synagogue. The prayer was read out in both Hebrew and English. People then had the opportunity to lay floral tributes following a minutes silence. Andy Wells, Harwich Town Council's Estate Supervisor, opened and closed the service. The children from both schools were warmly welcomed to the service and offered standing places at the very front. They were then invited to stand on the Kindertransport Memorial for a photo opportunity.

It was a pleasure to take Flynn and Georgia to this service and they did an amazing job (as always!) representing the school.
