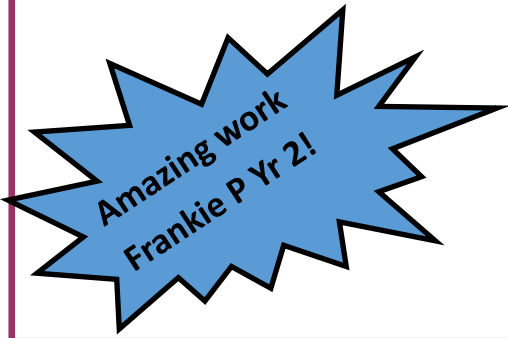
## This week's 'School Vision' Award goes to:
