Dear Parent/Carers,

I hope you all had a lovely half term break. This coming half term is my absolute favourite – we have so many activities and experiences planned (Christmas and otherwise) over the next six weeks.

On Tuesday, we held our first prospective parent tour during the school day. Parents came along to hear more about All Saints' before having a tour around the school. We have two more sessions left, one during the school day and one out of school hours. So far, the sessions held have been really well attended and there has been some amazing feedback. Please see the dates below if you have a child who is due to start in Reception in September 2025.

Thank you to everyone who has completed the Nursey provision survey that was sent round earlier this week. The Government are currently looking to create more Early Year's places and are offering funding to do this. We have been classified as a "Priority One" area; a potential space has been identified and the survey shows that there is a need and that we would be able to fill the places available. It will now all come down to funding. Unfortunately, the funding available from the Government only covers approximately two thirds of the building costs, so we are currently exploring funding options. The request to set up a Nursery originated from a couple of parents who attend our Baby and Toddler group – so thank you for the suggestion ladies. We will keep you updated on this very exciting venture.

On Monday, we are holding our Baby and Toddler Group at 2pm. There are only two sessions left this half term, due to a busy lead up to Christmas. If you have a child, from birth to preschool, please do feel free to pop along and join us. There is no need to book and space and it is open to anyone across Harwich, not just our All Saints' families.

Next Friday, the PTA are meeting to discuss the final arrangements for the School Disco and upcoming plans for a Christmas Fayre. If you are free at drop off time (8:45am start), then please do feel free to join us at the meeting. Next Friday will also be a non uniform day to raise money for Children In Need - please can we ask for a £1 donation per child for this.

Today, Erika and Olivia from Nite Owls visited the school. During a whole school experience, they introduced us to five (?) different owls and shared lots of information. Four children were lucky enough to be selected to wear protective gloves and have the owls fly from them to another child, across the hall. The owls were absolutely incredible and ranged from tiny to very large! Every child was then given the opportunity to have their photograph taken with Dotty the Barn Owl. Proofs of the photographs will be sent home early next week for families to purchase, should they wish.

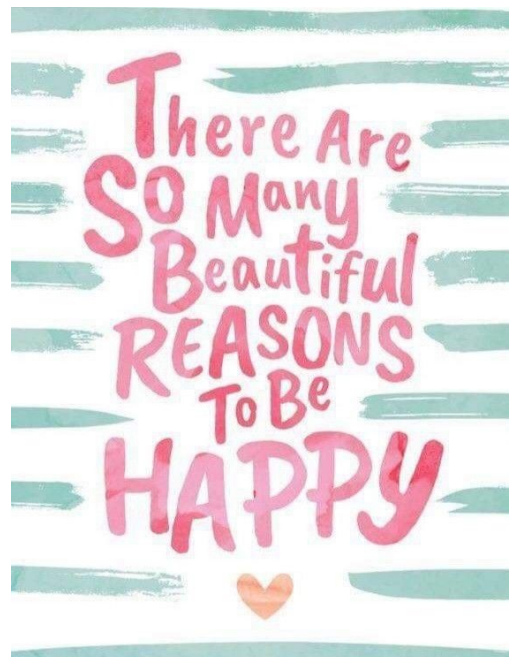
